

Beleura Private Hospital

Development Update # 5 December 5th 2011

Works on the new external corridor linking the kitchen with the hospital have progressed as planned; construction has been helped with relatively fine weather.

The timber framing is complete and roof timbers are in place in preparation for the roof to be installed later this week. The roof will be colour bond to match the existing roofing over the Nepean block. The image below [right] shows all timbers in place in readiness for roof iron.

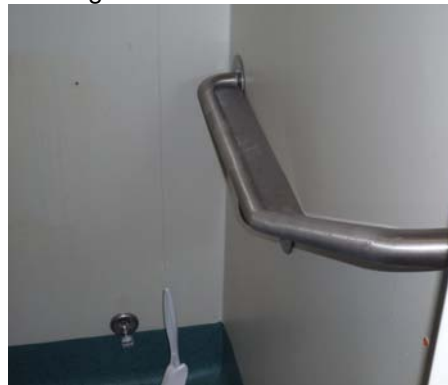


Internal works also continue in the old Flinders ward in preparation for relocating alcohol rehabilitation from its current home in Nepean. Works are intricate and involve re-fabrication of many of the existing fittings including hand rails in bathrooms and door handles. Wardrobes need to be refitted to remove any potential points from which patient might self harm. Re-fabrication detail of hand rail and ward robe rail are shown in the images below.



The Department of Health will visit Beleura on 7th December to assess building performance against compliance standards for mental health guidelines.

Pre Christmas date for relocation of Nepean to Flinders remains the target for these works to be complete.
